Monday

Wednesday

Read: Exodus 31

- 1. What did God give to Bezalel, Oholiab, and their families?
- 2. What is the significance of the Sabbath? (12–13)

Thursday

Read: Exodus 32

- 1. Why did the Israelites want to have an idol they could see?
