It's time for a midyear financial update, church family. Our leaders and staff continue to scrutinize expenses and look for revenue opportunities. We have had three fundraisers, two generous over and above donations from members and a generous memorial donation to the general fund from the Cottrell family. The congregation continues to generously support the church and ministries. As of the end of June, our expenses are \$33,000 below what was budgeted. That's all good news!

Here's the not so good news. As you know, and this is important, we do not have a balanced budget. Revenue for the summer months is running around \$3000 per month less than what was pledged. This is commonly known as the summer giving slump. It's understandable you're not thinking as much about church while you're enjoying your well-earned vacation and summer activities. But please take a look at your recent Contribution Statement to see if perhaps you need to do a little catch-up.
